


# Welcome to Potomac Rotary

#### In the beginning...

- The first Rotary club was organized in Chicago in 1905, by Paul P. Harris.
- The club, with four members, met in rotation at the offices of the members - thus the name Rotary.
- Growth began immediately. Less that 15 years later there were over 1,000 clubs around the world.
- > There are approximately 1.2 million members in over 35,000 clubs worldwide at present.



#### Rotary At A Glance

- Rotary brings together a global network of volunteers who dedicate their time and talent to tackle the world's most pressing humanitarian challenges. Rotary connects 1.2 million members from more than 200 countries and geographical areas. Their work impacts lives at both the local and international levels, from helping families in need in their own communities to working toward a polio-free world.
- Rotary also offers expanded service opportunities including:
  - <u>Interact</u>: a service organization organized and sponsored by Rotary clubs for young adults aged 12-18. There are more than 12,300 Interact clubs in 133 countries.
  - Rotaract: groups organized by Rotary clubs to promote leadership, professional development, and service among young adults aged 18-30. There are more than 8,000 Rotaract clubs in 167 countries.
  - Rotary Community Corps (RCCs): groups of non-Rotary members who work to improve their communities. There are more than 7,500 RCCs in 80 countries, all organized and sponsored by Rotary clubs.

### **History of Potomac Rotary**

- Chartered in 1960
- ➤ 26 Current Members
- ➤ District Recognition and Involvement
  - Home to largest number of District Governors
  - Home to the father of Polio Plus Program\*
  - Award winning Club

<sup>\*</sup> Polio Eradication: Rotary is close to eliminating the second human disease in history after smallpox, with a 99.9 percent reduction in polio cases worldwide since 1985, when Rotary launched it's <a href="PolioPlus program">PolioPlus program</a>. In 1988, Rotary spearheaded the creation of the <a href="Global Polio Eradication Initiative">Global Polio Eradication Initiative</a> with the <a href="World Health Organization">World Health Organization</a>, <a href="UNICEF">UNICEF</a> and the <a href="U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</a>. Polio eradication remains Rotary's top priority. To date, Rotary has contributed more than US\$1.6 billion and countless volunteer hours to help immunize more than two billion children against polio in 122 countries. Currently, Rotary is working to raise \$35 million per year through 2018 for polio eradication, which will be matched 2 to 1 by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
